### **2018 CARNEROS CHARDONNAY**

Carneros, California

This is a fantastic expression of California Chardonnay. Sourced from the Kiser, Home and Green Acres Blocks from Sangiacomo Vineyards, as well as a small amount of fruit from Truchard Vineyards. Picked at the peak of ripeness, our Chardonnay is barrel fermented for 10 months in American oak and left on the lees until we get ready to bottle. Flavors of tropical fruits, pear and apple are supported by rich notes of vanillin, leading into a powerful and succulent finish.

Composition: 100% Chardonnay, Malolactic Fermentation: 100%, Alcohol: 14.5%, pH: 3.45

### **2017 STA. RITA HILLS PINOT NOIR**

Sta. Rita Hills, California

This is our seventh vintage of Pinot Noir from the Sta. Rita Hills near Santa Barbara. The coastal influence of this region highlights the fruit's natural acidity and provides for an elegant presentation from start to finish. Submerged cap fermented in 100% stainless steel, barrel aged for 10 months in French oak and bottle aged for 12 months prior to release. This big, rich Pinot Noir has powerful notes of brambly fruits, cola and spice that are backed by toasty oak that provides depth, length and texture.

Composition: 100% Pinot Noir, Malolactic Fermentation: 100%, Alcohol: 14.5%, pH: 3.60

### **2018 PRESCRIPTION CHARDONNAY**

Clarksburg, California

Prescription Chardonnay grapes are sourced from Clarksburg and grown by a respected industry peer of our winemaker. Aged in 100% stainless steel and treated with oak, this Chardonnay has lively aromatics of high toned citrus, lemon peel, tropical fruits and fresh cream that lead into a refreshing and mouthwatering palate. Flavors of guava, papaya, key lime and crème brûlée flow throughout a long, smooth, mineral laced finish.

Composition: 100% Chardonnay, Malolactic Fermentation: 95%, Alcohol: 14.8%, pH: 3.45
